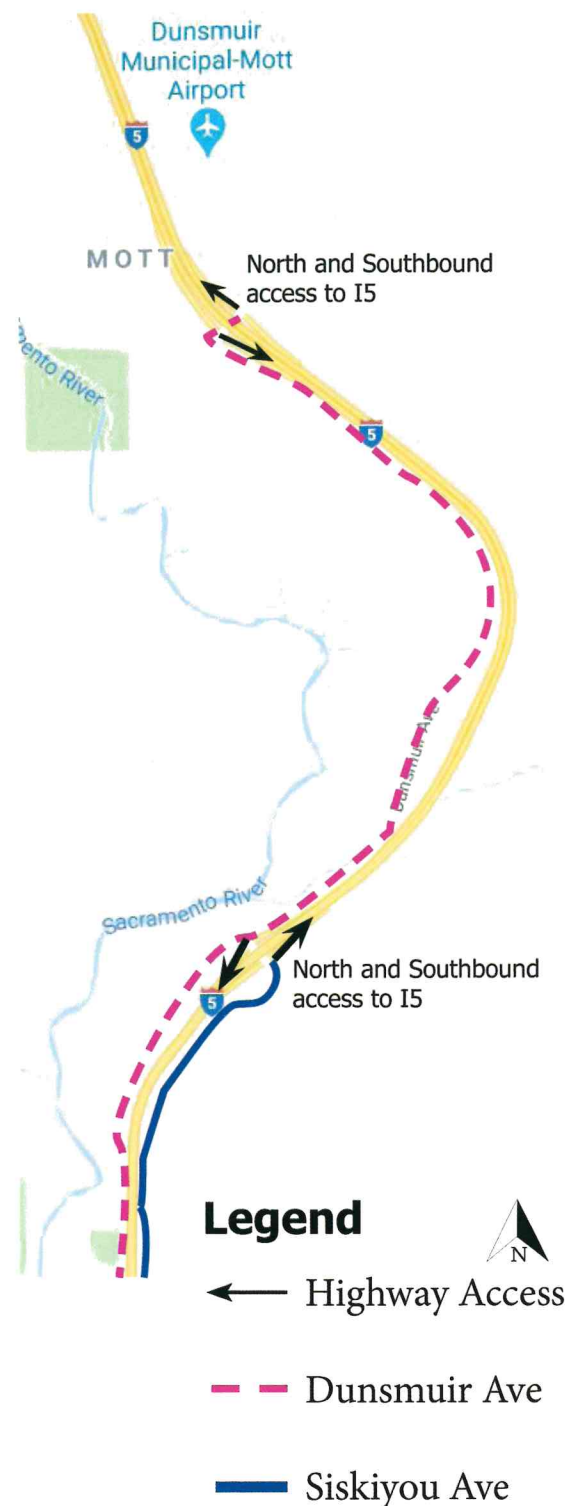
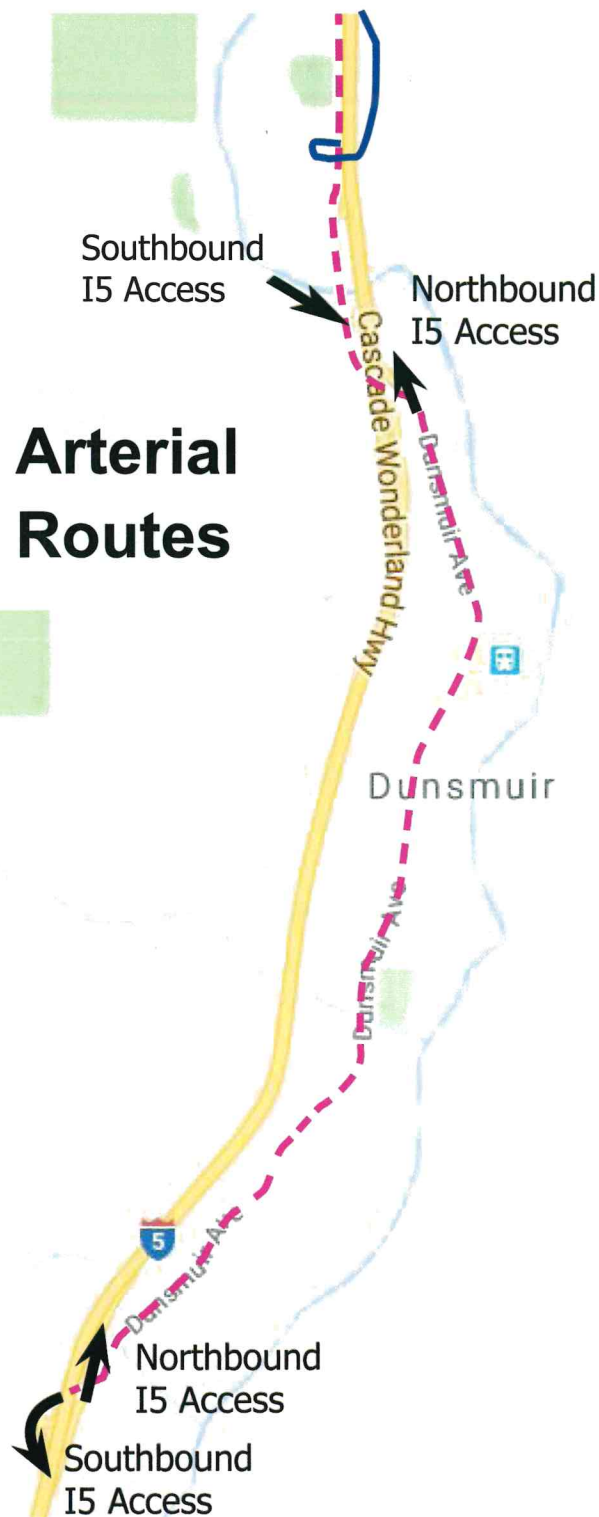


3. GO!

Leave as soon as evacuation is recommended by safety officials to avoid being caught in fire, smoke, or road congestion. Don't wait to be ordered to leave, in an intense wildfire, authorities may not have time to knock on every door. **Do not hesitate!**

- Officials will determine the areas to be evacuated and escape routes to use depending upon the fire's location, behavior, winds, terrain, etc.
- Law enforcement agencies will help with enforcing an evacuation order. Follow their directions promptly.
- You will be advised of potential evacuations as early as possible. You must take initiative to stay informed and aware. Listen to your radio or tv and monitor your phone for announcements from law enforcement and emergency personnel.
- You may be directed to temporary assembly areas to await transfer to a safe location.

KNOW THE LAW: BE READY TO EVACUATE

California Law authorizes officers to restrict access to any area where a menace to public health or safety exists due to a calamity such as flood, storm, fire, earthquake, explosion, accident, or other disaster. Refusal to comply is a misdemeanor. (Penal Code 409.5)
