



Important River Safety Information

As of September 14, 2023

An active cleanup and restoration project at the Dunsmuir Railyard to remove historic petroleum seepage impacted soil adjacent to the Sacramento River is in progress.

Construction is occurring where the public may want to engage in recreational activities.

Please keep in mind of the following during construction:

- In-river hazards exist to people floating, paddling, boating, or fishing around the Dunsmuir Railyard.
- An approximately 600-foot-long barrier consisting of large Supersacks filled with sand and rock have been placed in the Sacramento River in the City of Dunsmuir in preparation for excavation work in the railyard.
- River passage through the area is narrowed and can be hazardous to anyone recreating in the river by floating, paddling, boating, or fishing.
- The in-river barrier will be in place through December 2023.
